**CSU Transfer Units Required: 39 - Lower Division G.E. (30 Units with a "C" )**  
**+ 21 – Major Preparation/electives**  
**60 Transferable Units (min. for admission)**

Students should complete the **FOUNDATION** courses (English, Communication, Critical Thinking and Quantitative Reasoning) in the semester prior to transfer. Some CSU campuses will not allow these courses to be completed in the summer prior to admission. Courses used to satisfy one area, cannot be used to complete another.
