

## West Hills College Information for High School Students

Here are some things to think about:

1. As a high school student we welcome you to take West Hills College classes. All high school students may take classes at no charge for tuition. You are responsible for paying for all textbooks and supplies. This is a great opportunity to obtain some college experience!
2. You can earn *Dual Credit* at West Hills College and your High School. For every 3 units of West Hills College credit you may earn 10 credits of high school credit. Talk to your high school counselor to find out where the class you will be taking at West Hills College will transfer back credit to at your high school.
3. It is possible to earn or work towards your Associate Degree from West Hills College at the very same time you are going to high school working toward your High School Diploma.
4. Keep in mind that hard work does pay off! If you earn a 3.5 GPA (without any D's or F's) for at least 4 semesters during high school beginning your Sophomore year and are a member of CSF (California Scholarship Federation) you may qualify to go to West Hills College, Coalinga at no charge for 2 full years. To join CSF talk to your high school CSF advisor. You are considered a Presidents' Scholar. This scholarship also pays for up to \$250 of textbooks per semester. If you are Valedictorian or Salutatorian you also may qualify for free room and board. This is a great opportunity.
