



Employee training activities designed to meet the broad needs of the business and industry community coexistent with the regular ongoing, on-campus program are categorized as contract training programs. Such activities can be either at on campus or off campus sites. Because the extent of the activities is directly related to the District responding to identified workforce training needs of business and industry, components of the program will most likely include, but are not limited to, the following: contract programs, workforce training, economic development initiatives, developmental outreach, and interagency/client relations.

To that end, the Chancellor shall establish procedures for a contract training program whose purpose is to establish relationships with public and private agencies to offer specialized programs and/or classes on site or at other convenient locations in such areas as in-service training or classes designed to meet the specific needs of business and industry and other employers.
