RESIDENCE HALLS/STUDENT HOUSING

The Board recognizes its responsibility to make available the programs of the College District to all residents of the District. Therefore, the Board shall establish and maintain on-campus residence halls and contract food services at reasonable costs. Residence hall fees sufficient to cover room, board, and operations will be established by the Board of Trustees.

The residence halls are provided primarily to house students who are residents of the West Hills College District; and who live too far to commute to classes. Applications for on campus housing shall be considered in order of receipt.

Residence halls may be used for contract education/conference purposes.

Except for those students who live with a financially responsible sponsor, unmarried foreign students shall be required to live in on-campus residence halls.

The Director of Residential Living shall be responsible for receiving housing applications and assigning students to the residence halls. The Chief Student Services Officer (CSSO) shall establish rules and regulations for the use of residence halls and dining facilities. Students not abiding by the established rules and regulations will be denied the privilege of residence hall and dining facility use. All students residing in residence halls are required to be covered by an accident and health insurance policy.
