Application Process (Both ADN program and LVN-RN program)

- ◆ High School Diploma or GED or equivalent
- ◆ Minimum GPA 2.5 in Prerequisite coursework **AND** overall cumulative GPA for all college coursework taken at any/all colleges **foreign records evaluation/coursework see instructions to apply*
- ◆ Completion of Prerequisites (with minimum GPA of 2.5) **see comparable courses* link- **WHC Comparable Courses**
 - Anatomy 4.0 units
 - Physiology 4.0 units
 - Microbiology 4.0 units
 - English 1A 3.0 units
- ◆ Completion of Application- check website for application period and deadline **instructions to apply*
- ◆ Official Transcripts from **All** colleges/programs attended (failure to provide all college transcripts will cause application to be incomplete and therefor denied)
- ◆ Criminal Background Clearance- *post-acceptance into program (2nd stage of acceptance)*
- ◆ Health Screen Clearance/Physical



- ◆ *Current American Heart Association CPR Card - BLS Basic Life Support provider card* [*see example CPR card](#)
- ◆ Valid/current Auto Insurance
- ◆ ***LVN Program applicants MUST have a current and active LVN licensure*** in addition to the above listed requirements to apply.

Applicant Selection

TEAS Score

62% or higher TEAS score required for admission into program is applicant is selected. Pre-selected candidates only are offered one free TEAS test attempt on our campus to obtain 62% passing score for first attempt test takers. * Applicants be advised; not passing TEAS with this exam offering, they may lose their seat in the program if accepted.
