The IGETC is not an admissions requirement, nor does it guarantee admission to the campus or program of choice. Completing the lower division GE requirements, may improve a transfer applicant's chances for admission to a competitive campus and/or program.

All courses should be completed prior to transfer. However, if you are approaching readiness for transfer and are unable to complete one or two IGETC courses, you may be eligible to complete the IGETC after transfer. See your counselor for details and petition.

- ❑ Completion of Hist 17A or 17B AND Pol Sci 1 will satisfy the UC and the CSU Institutions requirement.

Transfer students wanting to major in Math, Science, Computer Science, Engineering, and those majors that require multiple courses in Math and Science (Area 5) can satisfy “minimum” admission requirements by completing 4 courses in at least two different GE subject areas (Area 3, Area 4 and Area 5) instead of completing the IGETC pattern.
