TYPES OF COURSES

1. Courses for which credit may be earned (those courses which are applicable to the A.A. degree, A.S. degree, or transfer to a four-year college).
2. Courses for which no credit is offered (those courses which do not apply to a specific two-year or four-year degree and which are short courses, programs and workshops designed to meet community needs).
