FOREIGN STUDENT ADMISSIONS

It shall be the policy of the Board that:

1. Foreign students wishing to be considered for admission must have all materials required for admission filed no later than an administratively established deadline
2. Foreign students must meet the admission requirement as specified in Board Policy 503 and Administrative Regulations.
3. Students wishing to enter spring semester will be considered by the Chief Student Services Officer (CSSO) on an individual basis.
4. Foreign students will present evidence of English Competence as specified by the College.
5. A foreign student who is on probation at another community college, or has been disqualified at another community college shall not be considered for admission to West Hills Community College District.
6. A foreign student who has been issued a visa to attend another institution shall not ordinarily be considered for admission to colleges within the West Hills Community College District.

Waiver of policy may be made if the regulations and procedures are in accord with the manual of federal non-immigrant laws.
