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

# Eureka

## Step-by-Step Guide

Covering many career related topics, including self-assessments, a guide to starting your own business, career descriptions, majors, colleges and universities, occupational descriptions in Spanish, a job search guide, funding finder and financial aid guide.

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
1. Open a web browser, like Google Chrome, and type in the URL **www.eureka.org**
2. In the member log in area, click on the **create account** link, and then enter in the *Eureka site ID code* **WNEVLC6** in the *My School/Agency Sent Me Here* box.



3. Once you are finished filling out the questions, log in with your created username and password. Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are required. You are not required to select a teacher/counselor.
4. When you login, you are taken to the **Dashboard**. The **Dashboard** options will allow you to start assessments, view career and occupational information, and find in depth description of majors, training programs, schools, financial aid and more.

## Dashboard Breakdown

If you choose the *Who am I?* option – which outlines a few short assessment tests you can take to learn about yourself and what direction you should go in regarding your career; *Where am I going?* – which gives you a couple worksheets you can fill out to explore careers, information on entrepreneurship and a job search guide; *How do I get there?* – which supplies you with databases that deal with education and training, a financial aid guide, and more worksheets.



### Step 1: Self-Assessments (Who Am I?)

#### Exploring My Personality, Learning Styles, Values, Skills and Potential Careers

Explore and define your personal attitudes and values with our engaging Self-Assessment strategies and Values Clarifier.

- A. **Inner Heroes:** Look at your **Personality**.
- B. **How Do I Learn:** Review your dominant learning styles(s) to help you develop study techniques.
- C. **What Are My Values?:** Discover your motivations and what is truly important to you.
- D. **MicroSkills** Explore your **Transferable Skills**. These can be used in many different careers or jobs.
- E. **True Colors:** Another view of your **Personality**.
- F. **Occ-U-Sort:** Which requirements of the labor market, including salary and education, are you able and willing to meet?
- G. **Career Assessment Worksheet:** Explore your Assessment results more deeply.

**Inner Heroes:** The 4 Inner Heroes types are: Helper, Planner, Thinker and Doer. People and careers are a combination of all four types. Inner Heroes Results will have career options for you based on your strongest type(s) but this does not mean other careers are not good for you.

**How Do I Learn:** Again, this shouldn't take more than twenty minutes to complete. This test will gauge your learning style based on a simple questionnaire.

**What are my Values?:** This test will give you an idea of what your life values are (for example, family, money, or power.) There will be a short written questionnaire at the end that will help decipher more of your personality.

**Microskills:** This assessment might take more time than the other small assessments offered. In this assessment you are presented with a list of skills and you have to decide which are the most important ones for you. Once you complete the Microskills assessment, you will get a list of jobs that would fit your personality well.

**True Colors:** This assessment is about your personality and how it may relate to possible careers. The 4 **True Colors** types are: **Blue, Gold, Green** and **Orange**. **True Colors Results** will have career options for you based on your strongest type(s) but this does not mean other careers are not good for you.

**Occ-U-Sort:** Gives you the exciting opportunity to look at your interests and abilities and relates your responses to potential careers.

**Career Assessment Worksheet:** You can also fill out a **Career Assessment** worksheet for your own personal use, or for a counselor to use.

## Step 2: Careers (Where am I Going?)

### Explore your Career Options

- A. **Career Exploration Worksheet Part I** Explore your assessment results more deeply.
- B. **Career Exploration Worksheet Part II** Explore your assessment results more deeply.
- C. **Entrepreneurship Database:** How to own and run your own business.
  - **Entrepreneurship Quiz:** Explore some of the things you need to consider before starting your own business.
- D. **Job Search Guide:** Explore all the things that can help you successfully search for a job.
  - **Job Search Strategy Worksheet:** Think about what you need to do for a successful Job Search.
  - **Information Interview Worksheet:** Be prepared for your information interviews.

**First:** Fill out two **Career Exploration Worksheets** that will help you outline possible future careers. These can also be taken to a counselor to be looked over.

**Second:** Look at frequently asked questions and information on entrepreneurship. You can even take a quiz to ensure your understanding on the subject.

**Third:** Information on **Information Interviews**, a **Job Search Guide**, and two **Worksheets** you can fill out to ensure better understanding of the subjects at hand.

## Step 3: Education (How do I Get There?)

### Explore Your Education and Training Options

#### A. Educational opportunities.

- **Education and Training Themes:** Themes based on True Colors with corresponding CTEs and College Major and Training Programs.
- **Majors and Training Programs** Post-secondary education and training opportunities and schools offering them.
- **Short-term Training Filter:** Select programs and features you want from schools and programs lasting less than 4 years. Includes Adult Schools, ROP training, and other other Certificate and Diploma programs.
- **Colleges & Universities Filter:** Select programs and features you want from 4-year Colleges/Universities and graduate schools.
- **My Preliminary Education Plan:** Plan for how to reach your educational goals.

#### B. **Financial Aid Guide:** Information for finding and applying for awards and scholarships.

### Educational Opportunities:

**Education and Training Themes**, outlines your themes from the previous assessments you took.

**Majors and Training Programs**, brings up a list of majors that you may choose. Clicking a major brings up possible careers, schools that offer that major, and information on the major and careers.

**Short-Term Training**, brings up a list of topics you can choose from to search for training degrees by location, degree type, financial aid, and a few other options.

**Colleges and Universities** link allows you to filter topics to search for colleges, like those in the short-term training link.

**My Preliminary Education Plan** link allows you to fill out a questionnaire that can help you understand what you want to get out of college and your future.

**Financial Aid Guide** offers information on financial aid and how to apply.


